Welcome to the Devon *Virtual Games* Events hosted by Active Devon and the Devon School Games Organisers. This series of events throughout the Autumn term will offer young people the opportunity to compete against themselves and others whilst maintaining social distancing.

- 2) The competition is open to any child who is a resident of, or attends school in, Devon. And for the mainstream competitions are aged between 5 and 16 and for the SEND competitions are aged between 5 and 19.
- 3) The entry process will be done via an online link issued by the School Games Organisers.
- 4) The closing date of each event will be publicised. No entries will be considered after these closing dates.
- 5) The parent/guardian is aware of the nature of the challenge and takes responsibility for ensuring a safe area for the challenge to take place. This involves, but is not limited to, the surface, the equipment, and the surrounding areas. You must ensure you are following the [guidance for teachers, school leaders, carers, parents and students](#). Or, if you are taking part at home or outside your home, please ensure you are following the [latest government guidance](#).
- 6) Active Devon and the Devon School Games Organisers will judge all entries and their decision will be final. No appeals process will be in place.
- 7) Medals and certificates will be awarded in line with the competition entry details.

- 8) Active Devon reserves the right to terminate the competition if circumstances arise that are out of our control.
