

SEND Dance Competition

Welcome to the Devon Virtual Games Events hosted by Active Devon and the Devon School Games Organisers. This series of events throughout the Autumn term will offer young people the opportunity to compete against themselves and others whilst maintaining social distancing.

All competitions are virtual, and you can enter as many of them as you like. The competitions are suitable to do at home, in your backyard or garden or at school. They give you the chance to team up virtually with your classmates, represent your school and compete against other children from across Devon!

The Autumn term series will run from the 14th September 2020 – 11th December 2020 with five different events for you to enter. Schools and home-schooled individuals will be able to submit their entries via an online link. Each competition will be open for a limited amount of time as detailed below.

You must ensure you are following the <u>guidance for teachers</u>, <u>school leaders</u>, <u>carers</u>, <u>parents and students</u>. Or, if you are taking part at home or outside your home, please ensure you are following the <u>latest government guidance</u>.

Brief Description of the Event:

- There is no limit on dancers allowed in a routine so can be performed by solo artists to class bubbles. All dancers need to be seen at all points while the dance is being filmed
- There is a choice of three levels and all the levels you can adapt to suit your abilities. The three levels are: READY, GET SET and GO

READY: Watch the <u>video here</u> and copy the dance. You can adapt this how you like to suit each child. The children in the video are all mostly doing the dance from a seated position.

GET SET: Watch the video and copy the dance. This is the same dance as for READY but there is greater movement in the dance. Again, this can be adapted as appropriate. You can do this on your own or in your class or year group bubble.

GO: Watch the video get creative by adding your own ideas to make the dance last approx. 3 mins. You can use parts of the set video dance in your choreography or completely rework this dance.

- The music will be the same for all levels and will be 'Best Day of my Life' by American Authors.
- You may use any other props that you like and can think about what you wear to perform your dance.

Prizes:

Everyone who takes part will receive a READY, GET SET or GO certificate.
