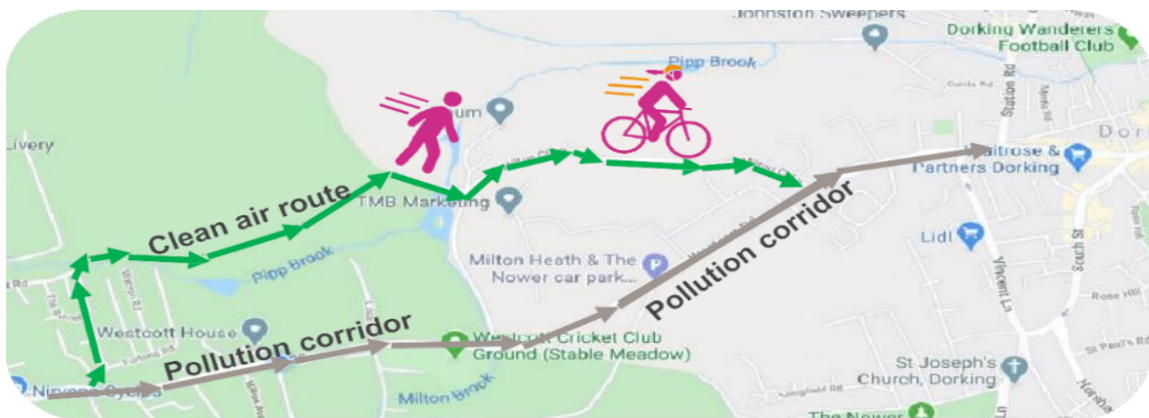

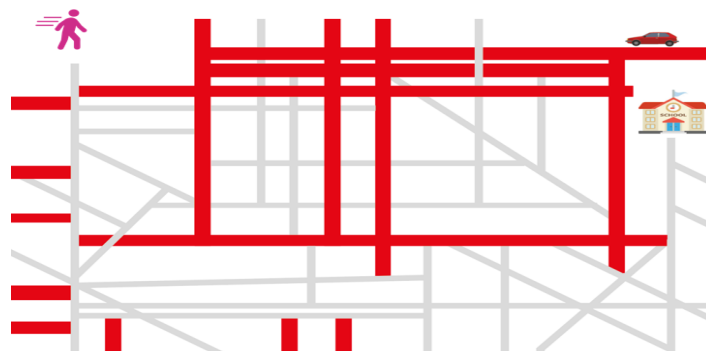

What is a Clean Air Route?

Clean air routes are alternative walking, scooting or cycling routes that allow individuals to avoid busy and polluted roads.

What Kind of Things Should We Think About When Planning a Safe Journey?

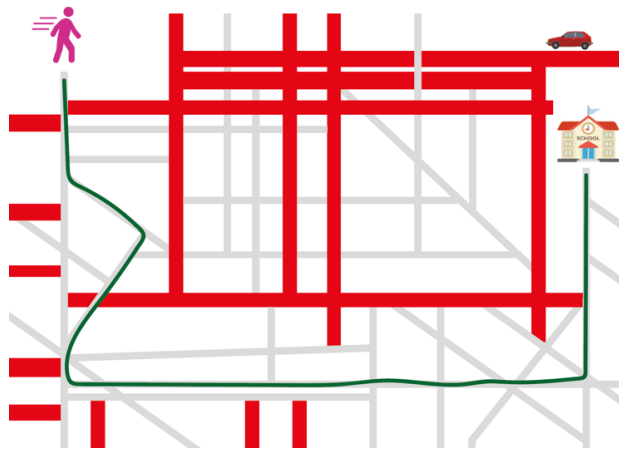
- Where do you want to go?
